

OLG COVID Report: Updated 6/26/21 Noon

The OLG COVID Task Force Team met last week to discuss changes to the school protocols for the upcoming school year. While we are still working with local school authorities to align our policies as much as possible, we want to inform our families of the two major changes that will occur in the coming school year.

Wearing masks will be optional for students during school hours.

Students' school attendance via Remote Learning will no longer be recognized by the TEA.

We still feel called to keep our students as safe as possible when they are on our campus, so we are keeping the Plexiglas in place for elementary students and continuing to do temperature checks in the morning. We will also be revising all other COVID protocols currently in our policy manuals with continued emphasis on student safety while attempting to return to "normal" as much as possible.
